7.2 Submission – MBIE ‘Granny flats’ proposals

Manager Resource Consents advised that, although in agreement with the direction of the proposal, there were concerns on some details and this had been reflected in the submission.

Manager Building noted that although there could be a reduction in consenting processing, there would be an increase in the non-compliance activity.

In response to a query regarding tiny homes on wheels, the meeting was advised that Council had taken a practical approach; if the ‘vehicle’ had a WOF/COF it was relocatable however more information from MBIE would be beneficial for further guidance in this area.

Mr Batchelar confirmed that one exemption condition was that the owners must notify the Council of planned work and on completion of that work.
