On the death of my mother Miria Wharewera
Ropiana I inherited shares in the homestead.

I support the submission of Cherie Diedre Latham
regarding the 10 metre strip between 25 A Keepa
Rd and 46 C State Highway 30, RDI, Whakatane.

This roadway has been a bone of contention
within the various whanau and is seen as an
attempt to divide and separate our hapu.

This family of the past and present have provided
additional parking when whanau hui, gatherings,
tangi are being conducted. The lack of necessary
parking for whanau attending marae gathering
is a further inconvenience for owners of my
grandparents homestead next to the marae. Even
still, with the use of both homesteads we must
utilise the entire drive of the marae commencing
at Keepa Rd through to the top of the driveway
in front of the marae. The suggested plan which
includes the roundabout formation on what is
the marae road can serve to further alienate
our whanau and hapu, impacting cultural
and traditional practices.
